

Debtors' First and Second Omnibus Objections to Certain Tier I Proofs of Claim (Duplicate Claims) (the "Duplicate Claims Objections").

By the Duplicate Claims Objections, the Debtors seek entry of an order disallowing and expunging certain duplicative proofs of claim (the "Duplicative Claims") filed in the Debtors' chapter 11 cases.

By order dated August 21, 2009, the Court established October 30, 2009 (the "Bar Date") as the deadline to assert a claim against any of the Debtors. On January 20, 2010, the Court entered an order approving the Debtors' Motion for Entry of an Order Establishing Procedures for Objections to Claims (the "Claims Objection Procedures Order"). Pursuant to the Claims Objection Procedures Order, the Debtors may file omnibus objections to claims that, among other things, are duplicative of other proofs of claim. While the Debtors seek to expunge the Duplicative Claims, the Debtors reserve their right, as well as the rights of any other parties in interest, to object to the surviving claims in the future.

The Duplicate Claims Objections have been scheduled for hearing on February 23, 2010 at 9:45 a.m. (ET), with a corresponding objection deadline of February 16, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. (ET).
