

Motion of Rohm and Haas Electronic Materials CMP Inc. for Allowance and Prompt Payment of an Administrative Expense Claim Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(9) (the “Rohm and Haas Motion”).

By the Rohm and Haas Motion, Rohm and Haas Electronic Materials CMP (“Rohm and Haas”) seeks entry of an order allowing it an administrative expense claim in the amount of \$180,011.10.

On March 9, 2009, Debtor Chemtura Corporation (“Chemtura”) and Rohm and Haas entered into an agreement (the “Agreement”) pursuant to which (i) Rohm and Haas agreed to purchase from third parties and sell to Chemtura certain raw materials (the “Goods”) to be used by Chemtura in the manufacture of products for Rohm and Haas and (ii) Chemtura agreed to allow Rohm and Haas to reduce its purchase price for such products by the purchase price of the Goods sold by Rohm and Haas to Chemtura. Rohm and Haas alleges that, based on a reconciliation of its books and records in accordance with the terms of the Agreement, Chemtura owed Rohm and Haas \$180,011.10 for Goods sold to Chemtura during the 20 days prior to the commencement of the Debtors’ chapter 11 cases, and that it is therefore entitled to an administrative expense claim pursuant to Bankruptcy Code section 503(b)(9). Rohm and Haas further requests payment of its administrative expense claim within 10 days of entry of an order approving the Rohm and Haas Motion.

A hearing will be held on the Rohm and Haas Motion on August 4, 2010 at 9:45 a.m. (ET), with a corresponding objection deadline of July 28, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. (ET).
