

Debtors' Motion for Approval of Stipulation and Order Regarding Assumption of Amended Contracts with TechniData America, LLC and Payment of Cure Amount Related Thereto (the "TechniData Motion").

By the TechniData Motion, the Debtors seek approval of a stipulation and order (the "TechniData Stipulation") authorizing Debtor Chemtura Corporation ("Chemtura") to (i) assume two executory contracts, as amended, with TechniData America, LLC ("TechniData") and, together with Chemtura, the "Parties") and (ii) pay related cure costs.

Prior to March 18, 2009 (the "Petition Date"), the Parties entered into a consulting agreement (the "Consulting Agreement") and a software maintenance agreement (the "Software Maintenance Agreement") and, together with the Consulting Agreement, the "Agreements"). Pursuant to the Agreements, TechniData provides the Debtors with software maintenance services and information technology consulting services (collectively, the "IT Services") related to ensuring that the Debtors' software systems properly classify the chemical substances manufactured and sold by the Debtors. The Parties allege that the IT Services provided by TechniData are important to the Debtors' businesses because such services help ensure the Debtors' compliance with various regulatory requirements.

On September 28, 2009, TechniData filed a proof of claim against Chemtura asserting a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$151,565.33 on account of obligations allegedly owed under the Agreements. On March 25, 2010, the Parties amended the Consulting Agreement and, on March 26, 2010, the Parties amended the Software Maintenance Agreement.

By the TechniData Motion, the Debtors now seek authorization for Chemtura to assume the Agreements, as amended, and pay cure costs (the "Cure Costs") in the agreed upon amount of \$75,782.67 (50% of amount of the general unsecured claim asserted by TechniData against Chemtura) within five business days of the Court's approval of the TechniData Stipulation.

The TechniData Motion is scheduled for presentment on July 29, 2010 at 12:00 p.m. (ET), with a corresponding objection deadline of July 22, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. (ET).
