COMMENCEMENT OF CASES. Petitions for reorganization under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code have been filed in this Court by the Debtors listed above, and orders for relief have been entered. Chapter 11 allows a debtor to reorganize or liquidate pursuant to a plan. A plan is not effective unless confirmed by the Court. You may be sent a copy of the plan and a disclosure statement telling you about the plan, and you might have the opportunity to vote on the plan. You will be sent notice of the date of the confirmation hearing, and you may object to confirmation of the plan and attend the confirmation hearing. The Debtors will remain in possession of the Debtors' property and may continue to operate any businesses.

LEGAL ADVICE. The staff of the bankruptcy clerk's office cannot give legal advice. You may consult a lawyer to determine your rights in this case.

CREDITORS MAY NOT TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS. A creditor is anyone to whom a debtor owes money or property. Under the Bankruptcy Code, a debtor is granted certain protection against creditors. In most instances, the filing of the bankruptcy case automatically stays certain collection and other actions against the debtor and the debtor's property. Under certain circumstances, the stay may be limited to 30 days or not exist at all, although the debtor can request the court to extend or impose a stay. Prohibited collection actions are listed in Bankruptcy Code. Common examples of prohibited actions include contacting the Debtors by telephone, mail or otherwise to demand repayment, taking actions to collect money or obtain property from the Debtors, repossessing the Debtors' property and starting or continuing lawsuits or foreclosures. If you attempt to collect a debt or take other action in violation of the Bankruptcy Code, you may be penalized. You may consult a lawyer to determine your rights in this case.

MEETING OF CREDITORS. *The Debtors' representative is required to appear at the meeting of creditors on the date and at the place set forth above for the purpose of being examined under oath.* Creditors are welcome to attend, but are not required to do so. The meeting may be continued and concluded at a later date without further notice.

CLAIMS. You may file a Proof of Claim in these chapter 11 cases. A Proof of Claim is a signed statement describing a creditor's claim. The Court has not yet set a deadline to file a Proof of Claim, but a deadline will be set in the future. **Separate notice of the deadlines to file Proofs of Claim, Proof of Claim forms and instruction regarding Proofs of Claim will be provided to the Debtors' known creditors.** A secured creditor retains rights in its collateral regardless of whether that creditor files a Proof of Claim. Filing a Proof of Claim submits the creditor to the jurisdiction of the Court, with consequences a lawyer can explain. For example, a

creditor who files a Proof of Claim may surrender important nonmonetary rights, including the right to a jury trial. Proof of Claim forms are available in the clerk's office of any bankruptcy court. Proof of Claim forms are also available from the Court's website at <http://www.nysb.uscourts.gov>.
