

Debtors' Third Omnibus Objection to Certain Tier I Proofs of Claim (Late-Filed Claims) (the "Late-Filed Claims Objection").

By the Late-Filed Claims Objection, the Debtors seek entry of an order disallowing and expunging certain late-filed proofs of claim (the "Late-Filed Claims") submitted in the Debtors' chapter 11 cases.

By order dated August 21, 2009, the Court established October 30, 2009 (the "Bar Date") as the deadline to assert a claim against any of the Debtors. On January 20, 2010, the Court entered an order approving the Debtors' Motion for Entry of an Order Establishing Procedures for Objections to Claims (the "Claims Objection Procedures Order"). Pursuant to the Claims Objection Procedures Order, the Debtors may file omnibus objections to claims that, among other things, were not timely filed. The Debtors believe that the Late-Filed Claims should not be enforceable against the Debtors' estates because the claimants failed to file their proofs of claim by the Bar Date.

The Late-Filed Claims Objection has been scheduled for hearing on February 23, 2010 at 9:45 a.m. (ET), with a corresponding objection deadline of February 16, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. (ET).
